# International News from Eritrea

## Abeba Habtom

Today, let us introduce you to Abeba Habtom, a lady full of energy and the conviction that nothing will ever change unless each of us goes out there to work for the “better world” we all long for. Far from any romantic notions, Abeba has grasped the opportunities that came her way, and is now working in early childhood development programs in Eritrea. She does visit Germany (among other place, naturally) at times, and Barbara Budrich is grateful to have had the chance of meeting her on one of these occasions. To promote what she is doing, Barbara asked Abeba to introduce herself, which she does in the following.

“Be the change you wish to see reflected in the world.” – *Mahatma Gandhi*

Unlike many children of my age, I was lucky enough to enjoy the benefits of education since my early years. This blessing spurred me to attend not only high school but also colleges. Since an early age I always dreamed of bringing about a tangible change in my small social environment. This dream taught me the need to explore possible avenues to making a contribution. Such a vision became bigger and more ambitious as I was getting older. This perspective aided me not to remain confined or limited to academic matters alone, but also prompted me to think more practical and be optimistic and ready for action.

I was born in Addis Abeba, Ethiopia, in the early 50's. Having completed my high school education there, I went to the United States for my further education. In the early 70's I joined the University of Maryland to study Business Administration. The University of Maryland in those days besides being a multi racial, multi cultural and multi ethnic campus, was a place where a significant degree of activism dominated. I realized that my academic way of life was being submerged by issues of the time involving the Vietnam War, struggles for racial equality, decolonization and the Cold War. When I think back on those days, I recall with wonder how much such issues overshadowed my academic work. Moreover, being from Eritrea, the bitter struggle that at the time was being waged for self-determination and human rights entered my world. When, in mid 70's I felt that I had to make my mind, in 1977







I took the decision to make a significant contribution for the then ongoing struggle.

Later on, during years of the struggle, I happened to work for the Eritrean department of social affairs. More specifically, my duty involved working with very young children. While doing so I understood what involved performing such duties. Not only did I grow to love the job, but also I determined myself that I was going to make the profession of my life. The national independence of Eritrea, which was achieved in the spring of 1991, provided me the opportunity to exercise my desire to assist children nationwide. The challenge was huge, but the

commitment of the people was as much. Now, in retrospect, I feel paid back. For the questions of social justice, fairness, equality that have been accompanying me all my lifelong now seem to be taking a firm hold and progressing.

The area that I am actively involved at is the Integrated Early Childhood Development Program. The goal of this program is to create sound foundation for healthy growth and holistic development of children. Its main objectives is to provide children with services and support catering to basic needs in health care, nutrition, protection, cognitive stimulation, affection, socialization and early education. Several ministries and communities are implementing agencies. I work as a coordinator of Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) Unit in the Department of General Education; which is one of five components. In the last ten years extensive achievements have been made in this program. For example, pre-school centers, which had been confined to few towns alone, expanded significantly to the most disadvantaged areas of the country - semi-urban, rural areas and villages. As a result, the number of centers increased from 90 to 497. Equally, enrolment rate of children has grown from 4.42% to 19.9% (GER). I participated in the development of policy, procedural guidelines, curriculum guides, and manuals.

Finally, it helps to recall that my education did not stop at Maryland. Over the past years of independence, I have been given opportunities to be educated via participation in workshops, conferences and seminars. On these occasions, I shared knowledge and experiences with people from different backgrounds concerning Early Childhood Development (ECD). Most important of all, I strongly believe my time came when a program called Early Childhood Development Virtual University (ECDVU) organized and run by the University of Victoria, Vancouver, Canada, which trains on matters of Early Childhood program in Africa through distance education, considered me and trained me in this field that I like the most. This golden opportunity helped me to earn an M.A. degree in ECD that I now happily practice every minute of my life.



Along the way I have as well learned that for someone who is determined to be part of the change, though the road may be tortuous and hard, success is possible indeed.

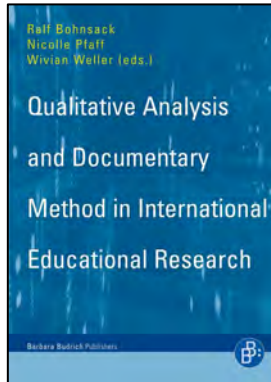

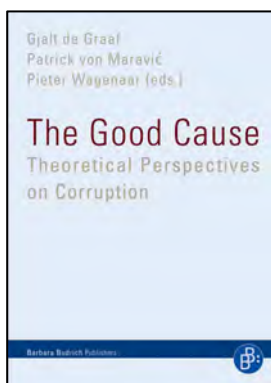

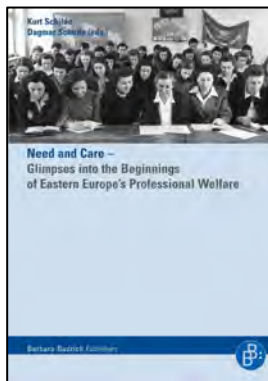
