Open Journal Systems (OJS)


The online editorial system is provided by the publisher Barbara Budrich. First register at https://www.budrich-journals.de/index.php/zem/user/register please.

Step 2: Uploading the submission


To upload, use the "Select file button" to select the desired file on your hard disk. It is important that you click on "Upload" before saving and continuing. If the upload was successful, the contribution file will appear under a corresponding file name.





Step 3: Entering the submission's metadata

In the next step you will be asked to enter metadata. This includes your personal data as well as an abstract. Please do **not** fill in the other fields about your curriculum vitae and institutions or organizations you may have supported.





Step 4: Uploading supplementary files

Here you are offered the possibility to upload additional data material (e.g. pictures or graphics). This step is optional.

If you have decided to upload additional files, a further step will appear. <u>Please do **not** fill in all the fields here</u>. Please enter the information about title, author, type and source and please inform us under "Short description" about the copyright for your selected material.





Step 5: Confirming the submission

This final step completes the upload of the submission. Here you will see your uploaded files. Afterwards, you can also view your submissions.

Editing status / publication of the contribution
